

THE AUSTRALIAN INTERSTATE PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION

The AIPC competition was initially formed in 1989 when it was known as the Allied Camera Clubs Competition.

The competition now known as the Australian Interstate Photographic Competition, (AIPC) comprises images selected by the state bodies of each Australian State and Territory.

Whilst it is not a APS competition, it is however always held in conjunction with the APS annual convention, APSCON.

APS provides Herbert Bronze medallions to the winning exhibit in each section and Merit Certificates are provided by the managing state to the top five entries in each section.

In 2012, 2013 and 2014 Victoria won the Alan Moran National Trophy awarded for the top scoring state across the competition.

In 2016 APSCON will be held in Adelaide October 12th to16th, see the APS website www.aps.org.au for all of the details.

Our state images will be judged and displayed alongside the other states entries, lets hope that we again show them that Victoria is the top photographic state and that we bring home the National trophy once again

Speaker/Workshop Profiles

Ian Rolfe

Professional Photographer Ian Rolfe specializes in landscape, seascape and fine art imagery. His love of light and his passionate approach to what light does to the landscape are evident in his photographs.

Given his first camera at the age of eight lan began taking monochrome photos of family and friends and also of the regular annual holidays he went on with his family.

A love of landscapes developed and flourished during a school camping safari to outback Queensland while attending secondary college. For over 45 years now, lan has honed and developed his unique approach to the Landscape and continues to be a devotee to the amazing beauty that's found in the great outdoors. With his busy schedule of specialized workshops, he still finds time to quietly pursue the "light" in the landscape.

lan has travelled extensively in Australia, South East Asia, the Himalaya's, United Kingdom, the Arctic Regions, North America, and much of the Pacific region, where he has built up an extensive photo library used in travel brochure work and his ongoing photographic writing.

Over the years, Ian has become quite a well-known travel and landscape photographer whose column started to appear in the Photo-master magazine about fifteen years ago. Since then, he has written and published over 130 articles, 3 books, and through the Getty International stock library, his images have been used in countless books, photography magazines, travel brochures and many commercial websites. Ian's photography, has been used by the National Library of Australia, The British Museum, The BBC, The National Park service, Qantas, French Geographic, Victorian Government, South Australian Wine council and many other fine media outlets and institutions.

He also conducts up to 12 Photographic Landscape workshops each year, both locally and to overseas destinations and also gives lectures and presentations at Club level throughout Victoria to help members who are passionate about developing further in their photographic knowledge and skills.

lan's Photographs have won many Gold Silver and Bronze medals, Best of Show, Merits and High commendations and received over 3000 acceptances at Photographic Exhibitions both here in Australia and at International Level. Ian is an accredited member of the AIPP, a Grand Master of the Australian Photographic Society, has been awarded the distinction "Artiste" from the International Society of Photographic art, and has also been awarded a medal for special services to the Victorian Association of Photographic societies.

Speaker/Workshop Profiles

Steve Axford

I live in the Northern Rivers area of NSW and I am retired from working as a manager and designer of large computer complexes. I now work on my photography and also restoring my land to something approaching its original native rainforest. My photographic interests cover many things including volcanoes, travel, people, wild-life and rainforests, with a particular focus on the fungi that live as part of the rainforest.

The Northern Rivers was once a huge area of uninterrupted subtropical, lowland rainforest and I have a little piece of it to look after and restore to the best of my ability. The native plants, animals and fungi (plus many other things) love it here, and it provides an ideal environment for much of my current photography. As my photography has developed, so has the international interest in it grown, to a point where I can hardly say that I am retired any more. I have been published in numerous European, Asian, North American and Australian magazines and books and have been invited to Moscow for an exhibition of my fungi photography at the White Rabbit Restaurant and to Yunnan in China, by invitation of the Chinese Academy of Science, to photograph their rainforest fungi.

In recent years I have gradually started spending more of my time with fungi timelapse and that has now become a major part of my work. Some of these timelapses will appear on the BBC series "Planet Earth II" later this year and in several other productions. I have also been invited to return to Yunnan to do some timelapse there.

My photography has been my avenue into the natural world as it slows me down and allows me to look at things more closely. I try to combine the beauty I see with scientific accuracy, so most of my photos could be used to identify things and will show the fine detail. The time-lapse that I take adds another dimension to an already fascination world and sometimes allows a glimpse into the world of interactions between different life forms.

Mark Galer is a seasoned professional photographer, educator, author, and contributing editor for Australian Photography and Digital magazine.

Mark is also the Adobe Photoshop/Lightroom Ambassador for Australia and all round Photoshop Guru. He has just published his 30th book with Focal Press, has served as a Senior Lecturer and Program Director of the BA Photography course at RMIT University in Melbourne and is the Sony Alpha Ambassador for Australia.

David Anderson

David Anderson, a budding rockstar with a fine head of hair, started shooting friend's bands around 1980 near Chicago.

After moving to Oz in 1984 and another failed drive for superstardom and brief marriage he went full-time and started shooting live music for various street press magazines in 1988. This lead to a regular gig at the then new Who Weekly magazine and then lots of work for the record companies and artists.

By 1995 David was too bald to be a rock star, but was one of the most published magazine photographers in Australia and was selling exclusive celebrity photos world-wide.

Highlights include photographing the Queen, touring with the Rolling Stones during Voodoo Lounge, being the ARIA music awards photographer for 21 years, 5 Farnham Album covers and 4 'Last Time' tours, shooting the Australian Idol finalists on various episodes of the show and a ringing in the ears that would silence Trump.

David is now mostly retired and concentrating on his fly fishing work for <u>twigwater.com</u> and raising all his wives' many, many children. With the exception of the ringing ears, they all live a quiet life in Albury NSW.

"I love the peace, the colours, nature and the sheer rawness of the landscape," he said. "Nature has a way of selecting the colours and patterns"

"It's about listening to the land and being aware of what you are feeling and seeing.

"Nature is so powerful and our supreme ruler - even though humans think they are the ruler, nature will always have the last say."

These days he shoots his images from a four-seater Glasair Sportsman, a tail dragger ideally suited to bush flying. David uses a medium-format camera Phase One 645 and a Canon 5D.

While living and working with livestock, David developed a deep spiritual connection with the land, based on years of being at peace with nature and what it offers.

The vastness of our wilderness is vital for our spirit and creativity. To witness the self -sustaining ecosystem is a privilege David hopes to share with you.
