IMAGE PREPARATION

- Images must have been captured on or after 1 January 2021.
- Images must be in JPEG (.jpg) or PNG (.png) format and should be at least 2500 pixels on the longest edge. Image file size should be no larger than 5MB.
- Do not include watermarks, logos or any other branding on your images.
- Image file names should not include unusual characters, eg ©, @, #, \$, &, *, etc. These characters have caused problems with images uploading to the website. If you find that one of your images has not uploaded correctly, please email us at hello@thelandscapeawards.com.au
