## BCC MEMBERS NOTICE BOARD

### CAMERA RAIN COVERS

A couple of members asked about rain covers, if they are worth buying or not? There's no one single answer for this. But for those who want to shoot in wet weather they are an excellent way to give your camera extra protection, especially more basic models that don't tend to have any or very little weather proofing. There's 3 general options: Premium, made from hard wearing material that is water proofed (generally high grade rip-stop nylon). Standard, made from durable clear plastic (hard wearing, waterproof, but susceptible to tears & punctures, so needs to be checked regularly to save any heartaches). DIY, one that I have used regularly over time with great success. All of my camera bags over time have contained 2-3 plastic shopping bags, numerous rubber bands in all shape and sizes and a number of shoe laces, as I have so often had good use for them, one of those has been water proofing cameras when you find yourself caught in a storm during a shoot. It's a quick, cheap and highly useful option. Another option is put your camera on a tripod and use a good umbrella to keep the rain off, don't let rain dampen your enthusiasm, many great shots are taken in the wet. For those who are after a commercial version I've added a few options below with links.
