For the sake of convenient comparison, lenses are often referred to by their '35mm equivalent (which is the tradition 35mm Film Format also known as 'Full Frame' in Professional Digital Cameras') focal length; for example a 18-55mm kit lens for APS-C may be described as a 28-90mm equivalent. This means simply that an 18-55mm lens on an APS-C format camera covers the same angle of view as a 28-90mm lens does on a *full-frame camera.* *Crop Factor - Lens size x CF = 35mm Equivalent.

Eta Aquariid Meteor Shower

Night Skies, Bendigo VIC Wed 19th April - Sun 28th May

At it's peak the Eta Aquariid Meteor Shower can produce up to **50 meteors** an hour.

But in order to see them you need to get to an area where you have dark skies and very little light pollution. For the darkest locations please check the link below to the Blue Marble website for the best options.



For those brave enough to face the early hours of the morning and are willing to try and catch a shooting star as it fizzes it's way across the night sky, then this is the time to give it a try. This year will have reduced visibility as the moon will be full in the night sky making it hard to see all but the strongest meteors.


Old Treasury Building Exhibitions

The Old Treasury Building has a long history in Victoria and is widely regarded as one of the finest 19th century buildings in Melbourne, designed by nineteen-year-old architect JJ Clark and built between 1858 and 1862. Sitting at the top end of Collins Street in the Melbourne CBD, it hosts the original gold vaults where gold bullion was stored during the gold rush era, as well as rare and historic documents from Public Record Office Victoria highlighting key moments from Victoria's history, what better place to host exhibitions of historic value such as those currently being held until December this year: 'Lost Jobs: The Changing World of Work, Protest Melbourne, A Nation Divided: The Great War and Conscription, Women Work for Victory in WWII, etc'. 


