BCC Photo Competition Set Subjects 2025

Get a head start on the Set Subjects for the BCC Photographic Competitions 2025. As each current Competition is in play a more comprehensive description (definition) will be added to that subject in the hope that it will help members define what they wish to shoot. If you are still uncertain of what to shoot, please ask any of the Committee Members for help and they will attempt to give you more guidance.

ARTIFICIAL LIGHT Due Tuesday 14th January 2025

Use man-made lights such as studio lights, flashes, or street lamps, to enhance your subject/s for visually compelling results.

Artificial light refers to any light source that is man-made, including studio lights, flashes, LED lights, and other lighting equipment. The focus is on how photographers manipulate and control artificial light to enhance their subjects, create mood, add colour, highlight textures, or craft dramatic effects. Entries should demonstrate a strong understanding of lighting techniques, showing how artificial light can be used to shape, define, or transform the subject matter. Participants are encouraged to push the boundaries of artificial lighting to produce visually compelling and innovative photographs.

PORTRAITS

Due Tuesday 11th February 2025

Convey a story or emotion through your image of a person. Create a mood by highlighting facial expressions, body language, and/or the environment in which the subject is placed.

INTENTIONAL CAMERA Due Tuesday 8th April 2025 MOVEMENT

Create abstract, impressionistic, or dynamic effects by moving the camera during exposure. Showcase artistic use of camera movement to convey emotion, atmosphere, or unique interpretations.

Due Tuesday 10th June 2025 TRIPTYCH (SERIES OF 3 **IMAGES**)

Create a cohesive, visually engaging work using three distinct images that, when combined, convey a unified idea or artistic expression.

AUSTRALIANA Due Tuesday 12th August 2025

Showcase the spirit of Australia. Explore landscapes, wildlife, culture, and iconic elements. Convey a sense of place, culture, and distinctive qualities. Offer a compelling and authentic glimpse into what it means to be Australian.

STRUCTURES Due Tuesday 9 September 2025

Photograph man-made structures. Focus on form, space, light, design, and aesthetics. Highlight visual appeal, historical significance, or cultural context. Offer a fresh perspective or artistic interpretation.



Two Comets in the Night Sky



The Night Skies

Not one, but two comets might grace our skies in October 2024.

- Look West after sunset for Comet C/2023 A3 (Tsuchinshan-ATLAS) beginning around mid-October.
- Look East before sunrise for the sungrazer, Comet C/2024 S1 (ATLAS), beginning in late October

Heads up, comet-watchers! The ATLAS survey in Hawaii has discovered another new comet that could become bright in Earth's skies. The discovery date is September 27, 2024. The comet is so new it's still waiting for its name. But for now it has the designation of A11bP7I.

In the meantime, don't forget the other comet in Earth's skies right now. C/2023 A3 Tsuchinshan-ATLAS will be visible in the evening sky after about October 12. 



The Orionids Meteor Shower are active every year in October, usually peaking around October 20/21. At its peak, up to 20 meteors are visible every hour. The Orionid meteor shower is the second meteor shower created by Comet Halley. The Eta Aquarids in May is the other meteor shower created by debris left by Comet Halley that takes around 76 years to make a complete revolution around the Sun. It will next be visible from Earth in 2061. Orionids are named after Orion, because the meteors seem to emerge or radiate from the same area in the sky as the constellation.





Remembrance Day

At 11 am on 11 November 1918 the guns on the Western Front fell silent after more than four years of continuous warfare. The Germans had called for an armistice (suspension of fighting) in order to secure a peace settlement. They accepted allied terms that amounted to unconditional surrender. The 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month attained a special significance in the post-war years. The moment when hostilities ceased on the Western Front became universally associated with the remembrance of those who had died in the war. This first modern world conflict had brought about the mobilisation of over 70 million people and left between 9 and 13 million dead, perhaps as many as one-third of them with no known grave. The allied nations chose this day and time for the commemoration of their war dead.




