TRIPTYCH - (Series of 3 Images) Due Tuesday 10th June 2025


Create a cohesive, visually engaging work using three distinct images that, when combined, convey a unified idea or artistic expression.



My interest in photography stemmed from my grandfather's collection of tools, drafting equipment and camera gear. He owned a German Paxette 35mm camera with a separate light meter. My first roll of film didn't stay attached to the sprocket so the whole roll came back blank.

In my early days in the Camera club, meetings were held at the Department of. Agriculture in Epsom.

Judges were mainly local, from the Bendigo Institute of TAFE and the Advanced College of Education, later Latrobe University.



There were many memorable outings to the Grampians and VAPS conventions, held at various locations, all over the state. Some of my lifelong friends are still in the Camera club today. Our family holidays were often based on suggestions of club members and standout photo entries in club competitions.



I am grateful for the influence both Rob and Cynthia Watkins have had on all aspects of my photography.

I did develop and print black and white film and prints as a direct result of being in the club, amongst some top print makers. We also learnt to cut and mount our own prints as this was a key point of judging.


I still remember the controversy over introducing commercially produced prints; not to mention the slow drawnout adoption of digital photography.
